## **Pre-Registration for the 2022 – 2023 School Year**

It is that time of year again where we ask you to pre-register your student for the upcoming 2022-2023 school year. Please take a moment to log into your PowerSchool Parent Portal (<https://powerschool.mtnhomesd.org/public/home.html>) and update your student's information by May 30<sup>th</sup>. Not only will this allow you to make sure all of your student's information is correct, but it will also allow us to prepare for next year by knowing who will be returning. Unfortunately, this cannot be done via the app and needs to be completed through a web browser.

## **You Can Help**

The Idaho Legislature passed HB790 this session which includes a formula for distributing \$72 million in Literacy Funding. To help ensure our district receives the most funding we can, we ask that you please complete the Free and Reduced Application at [www.mymealtime.com](http://www.mymealtime.com) or by picking up a form at the office. If you have already filled out the form this year, you don't need to do it again. All students that qualify this year, will be eligible for Free or Reduced Meals for the first 30 days of school next year, however, would still need to fill out an application next year before the 30 days are up. Thank you for your assistance and we apologize for the timing of everything. All applications need to be completed by May 25<sup>th</sup>.
